

The Logan and Gold Coast Faster Rail project will double the number of tracks between Kuraby and Beenleigh and connect growing communities with more frequent and reliable train services.

Overview

November 2023

Bethania station is being upgraded to improve accessibility, safety and customer experience. The new station will feature a range of improvements to allow the community to travel more easily, including straightened and raised platforms, increased platform coverage, new lifts and improved park 'n' ride facilities.

To make it safer and easier for the community to move around, the level crossing at Station Road, Bethania will be closed and replaced with a road-over-rail bridge. Due to strong community feedback in support of local facilities, an alternative design has been developed which avoids permanent impacts to the Bethania Waters Shopping Centre and reduces impacts to the Aquatic Centre.

Better cross-corridor pedestrian connections will be created with a new pedestrian overpass at the station, going over both the rail line and Holzheimer Road.

All station upgrades will be designed and constructed in compliance with the *Disability Discrimination Act (1992)* to provide and improve accessibility for all users.








Bethania station proposed layout
